Purpose for Volunteer Assignment: SSCHC partners with south side schools to provide afterschool programming. Titled KK River Explorers, the program focuses on place-based environmental health and outdoor recreation with student creation of a field guide explaining various aspects of the Kinnickinnic River Watershed. Participants are 4 th & 5 th grade students at Lincoln Avenue & Windlake Elementary Schools. Lessons are taught at the schools with outings to Pulaski Park and the Kinnickinnic River Trail. Programming runs in the afternoon, Monday through Thursday, from late February to late May (more detailed schedule information below).
