 - **Mission:** To improve lives, strengthen communities, and foster civic engagement through service and volunteering.
- **Sixteenth Street Community HealthCorps**
 - **Hours:** Members serve a set number of hours within their service year (called MSY for Member Service Year) to provide various services to the community while gaining professional development experience and ultimately earning an education award to pay for higher education!
 - **MSY slots include:**
 - **1,700 hours** for an education award of **\$6,345.00**
 - **1,200 hours** for an education award of **\$4,441.50**
 - **900 hours** for an education award of **\$3,172.50**
 - **Service Year:** September 2021 to July 2022
 - **Our purpose:** Enhance capacity of host-site departments and provide crucial services that reflect the needs of our community and clinic patients.
